

CasaTunes Setup (Cont)

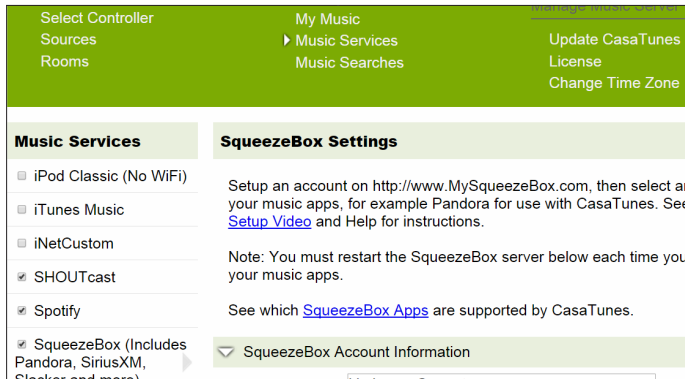
In the **AirPlay** section, decide whether you want to allow music on iOS devices to be played through the Streams.

NOTE: Do Not change the “Enable transmitting CasaTunes music to AirPlay speakers” or “Always turn off room when the AirPlay stream disconnects” checkboxes. They have no affect in multi-stream player mode.

You will not be able to play CasaTunes music out to AirPlay speakers when using multi-stream player mode.

You will be able to play music from an iOS device or iTunes to a CasaTunes Stream and then select the rooms, volume and power using the home control system.

Enable all of the music services you are interested in. Some music services require setting up SqueezeBox. Follow the directions in CasaSetup.



Some music services require paid accounts, as noted in CasaSetup.

Now, set your Time Zone and Update settings. Click on Advanced Settings and use the Project Information page to create a backup of the project.

Quick Start Guide: CasaTunes CT-1&2 as Multi-Stream Player



Use this guide only when using CasaTunes to supply streams for RTI, URC and Control4.

(CasaTunes not controlling the distribution of audio)

Network Cable Qty 1



Serial Cable Qty 1 (Not used in multi-stream player mode)



Power Adapter Qty 1



3.5mm to RCA

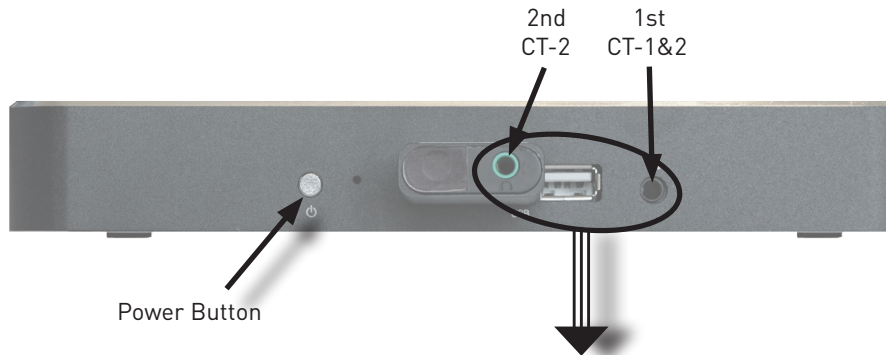
Audio Cables Qty 1 (CT-1) or 2 (CT-2) each type

Connect CasaTunes Stream outputs

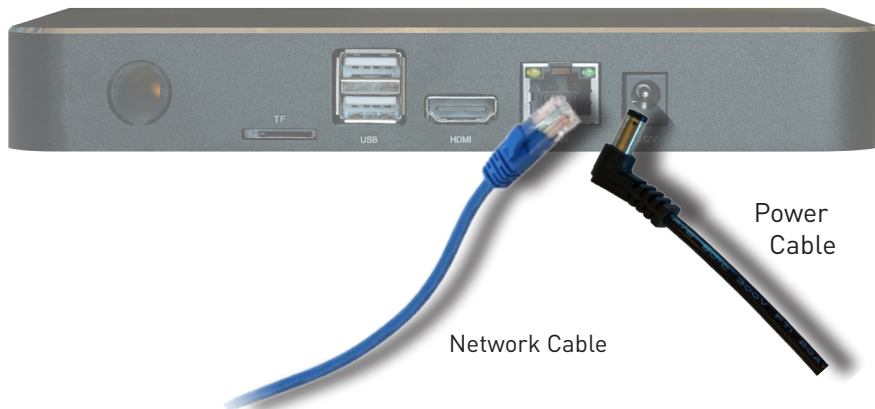

Stream Outputs

Connect to inputs of distribution systems or AVRs controlled by home control system using supplied audio cables.

Connect to LAN and Power



CasaTunes Setup

Turn on the system at this time.

Open a browser on any computer on the LAN and go to CasaSetup:

PC: <http://CasaServer/CasaSetup>
Mac: <http://CasaServer.local/CasaSetup>

Use CasaSetup, **Select Controller**, click on Advanced and check the box to configure the music server as a multi-stream player.

Controller Settings

Select Controller Type: CasaTunes CT

Are you using a CasaTunes CT-3, CT-3S or CTMS-3 music server or streamer?

Configure music server as a multi-stream player?

In the **Sources** section, simply rename the stream(s) from Player 1 (and Player 2 on the CT-2).

A good suggestion might be to name them after the home owner's names, like this:

Built-in Sources	Alison's Music Settings
Alison's Music	Source name: Alison's Music
Bill's Music	<input type="checkbox"/> Hide Source
